New Electric Aggregation Plan (EAP) Appendices

CPCNH has drafted two additional appendices for inclusion in all Member CPA Electric Aggregation Plans (EAPs), in response to the NH Public Utilities Commission's request for additional clarifications regarding (1) the planned implementation of Load Serving Entity (LSE) services and (2) individual customer data security and confidentiality.

The City of Lebanon is the first CPCNH Member CPA to incorporate the new appendices, and Lebanon's City Council has scheduled a vote to discuss and adopt their amended EAP on June 15, 2022.

An updated version of the Lebanon's EAP with the proposed amendments, accompanied by a two-page introductory memorandum written by Clifton Below (Lebanon's Assistant Mayor and CPCNH's Chair of the Board), has been posted to the [RFP Dropbox Folder Link](#) on CPCNH's [Solicitation webpage](#) for reference. Note that proposed amendments are shown in track changes, except for the body of Attachments 9 and 10 (the two new appendices), which are entirely new and not shown in track changes except the title headers.
